Expressions of interest for members of Community Consultative Committee (CCC)

Expressions of interest are being sought for community members for a CCC for the Gullen Range Wind Farm. Up to 6 positions are available for community representatives.

The purpose of the CCC is to provide a forum for discussion between representatives of the applicant, the community, councils and other stakeholders on issues directly relating to the operation of the Gullen Range Wind Farm.

Ongoing community relations are also an important function of the committee. It is anticipated that the CCC will meet regularly for the life of the wind farm.

Committee members will be appointed as individuals and will not be expected to represent specific organisations. Candidates will be selected to allow a broad cross section of views to be brought to the committee.
