Gullen Range Wind & Solar Farm

BJCE Australia owns Australia's first co-located wind and solar farm, which stretches 22km, approximately centred on the locality of Bannister, 11km south of Crookwell.

Gullen Range has 73 turbines and an installed capacity of 165.5 Megawatts (MW) whilst the 28 hectare solar farm has 42,000 panels, which at full power produce 10MW of electricity.

On an average day of wind and sunshine, the facility can power more than 70,000 average homes.

Crookwell 2 Wind Farm

Global Power Generation opened the Crookwell 2 Wind Farm in November 2018 with 28 turbines and a capacity of 91MW. This is enough to supply 42,000 homes in Canberra and helps the Australian Capital Territory towards its goal of 100% renewable electricity.

Crookwell 2 is an 8 minute drive southeast of Crookwell on the road to Goulburn and is notable for being beside the original 5MW Crookwell 1 Wind Farm commissioned in 1998 as the first grid connected in Australia.
